2024 Major Accomplishments

- El Dorado Traffic Master Plan
- Road Condition Assessment
- New building permit valuation of \$12.4 million, including 26 new residential buildings
- Created VIN Inspection Program



2024 Major Accomplishments

- Traffic signal upgrades, including battery backups and new sensors
- Installation of ~ 5,500 automated meters
- Cured-in-Place Pipe project completed - 2,149 feet (Lawndale/Arizona)
- Continued progress on ballfield project, including completion of concession/restroom facilities, scoreboard installation, irrigation, fencing and parking lots



2024 Major Accomplishments

- Moved public notices onto the website as the official publication
- Compensation Study
- Completed Mural Plaza
- Police Drone Program implemented

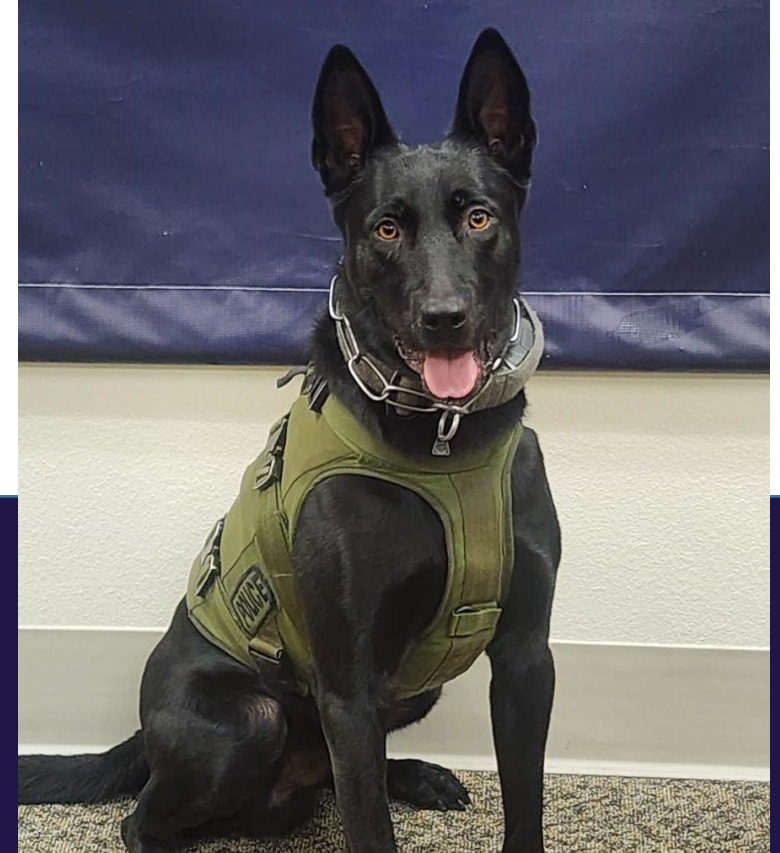


2024 Awards/Grants

- Award of Safe Streets and Roads For All Grant
- Award of City Connecting Link Improvement Program (CCLIP) Grant for Central Avenue
- KDOT STEP grant for PD overtime and STEP Equipment Incentive for \$4,500
- Patrick Leahy Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant 2024-25
- \$5,000 Donation for K-9 Unit

2024 By the Numbers

- 1,747 total fire calls for service, with an average response time of 5:35
- 325 business inspections were completed by the Fire Department
- The K-9 Unit had 54 deployments, resulting in 28 arrests and assisted 7 outside agencies



2024 By the Numbers

- 2,506 citations or cases were filed, containing 3,105 violations
- The Police Department worked 1,929 cases (an increase of 25 percent from 2023) and 13,789 total incidents
- The City Facebook page reached 5,700+ followers



2025 Department Goals/Projects/Initiatives

- Central Avenue Project
- Constant Creek Sewer Interceptor Project
- Implement street surface treatments that will extend the life of city streets
- Installation of novice disc golf at Graham Park



2025 Department Goals/Projects/Initiatives

- Continue McDonald Stadium updates and ballfield improvements
- Implement sewer flushing program targeting 1/3 of the city annually
- Implement .GOV on the city's URL and email system
- Develop CIP for Transportation Master Plan
- Develop a comprehensive debt management plan
- Increase public engagement in the budgeting process
